

MONDAY - OCTOBER 22 - Speaker - Ashley- Engles-Ross from Operation Home Front

Ashley is from Pittsburgh, Pa where she attended the University of Pittsburgh and received a BA in Social Work before joining the Army to serve as a Combat Medic and Psychiatric Technician. Her first duty station was here at Fort Bliss, which is where she met and married her husband, Command Sergeant Major James Ross. While her husband deployed, the first time, she attended the University of Texas at El Paso where she earned a Masters in Public Administration. Jim and Ashley have been married for 14 years and in that time she has had the privilege of serving our military families in a variety of ways, most recently as the Community Liaison for Operation Homefront here at Fort Bliss.

Operation Homefront is a national not for profit, 501(c) 3, organization that provides emergency and other assistance to all of our Wounded Warriors and their families, as well as our mid-grade and junior enlisted military families. We have 23 offices around the country serving 41 states, and our national office in San Antonio, TX manages cases in states that do not have a field office. We have been given a 4 star rating, the highest a charitable organization can receive for 6 years from Charity Navigator, the nation's top independent evaluator of nonprofit organizations. Nationally, \$.94 of every dollar donated to Operation Homefront goes to programs.

We aspire to become the provider of choice for emergency financial and other assistance to the families of our service members and Wounded Warriors. It is my goal to develop widespread public support and build a collaborative team of exceptional volunteers both in the community and amongst our service members that are committed to making this goal a reality.

We are currently registering families and sponsors for our Adopt-a-Family program. This program allows families, individuals and organizations to help a military family with holiday expenses by purchasing a holiday meal and a toy for each child in the family. We have also just kicked off our holiday toy drive, which supports our Operation Jolly Holly. Operation Jolly Holly will provide 1200 children on Fort Bliss with toys for the holidays. Mazda West and Mazda East have offered to be collection points for anyone interested in donating toys. In addition the German Club on Fort Bliss, as well as the United States Sergeants Major Academy will be holding toy drives in support of Operation Jolly Holly!

District Governor - Mark Glenn gets his "boots"

Every year several of the Rotary Clubs in El Paso collect funds to buy the District Governor a pair of cowboy boots as a gift for his hard work and dedication to Rotary in the El Paso area. 




