

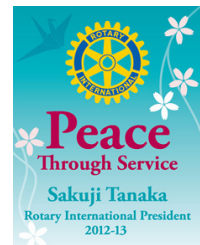

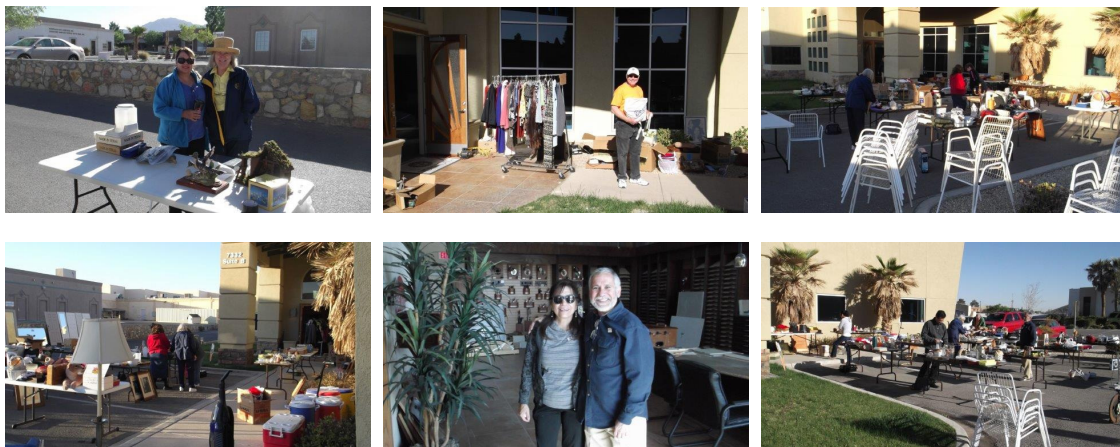

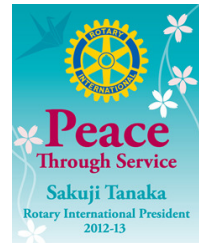

**President's Message (Happy Birthday - Paul Harris – Founder of Rotary)**



PAUL P. HARRIS

*As he appeared when Rotary came into being  
February 23, 1905*

**Paul Harris was born in Racine, Wisconsin on April 19, 1868.** He was the second of six children of George N. and Cornelia Bryan Harris. He attended the University of Vermont and Princeton University and received his law degree from the University of Iowa in 1891. In 1896, he settled in Chicago and opened a law practice.



Along with Gustavus Loehr, Silvester Schiele, and Hiram Shorey, (shown above) he founded the Rotary Club of Chicago in 1905 and was elected its president in 1907. He wrote several books about Rotary and his life and travels, including *The Founder of Rotary* and *This Rotarian Age*. He was also recognized by the Boy Scouts of America and honored by the governments of Brazil, Chile, the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, and Peru. Paul Harris died on January 27, 1947, at the age of 79, leaving a rich legacy of fellowship, professionalism, service, and friendship. His passing also sparked an outpouring of donations to The Rotary Foundation from all over the world.
