The slate of officers and directors was presented at the regular meeting on December 8. The vote on the officers had been postponed and will now be held this coming Monday, January 12.

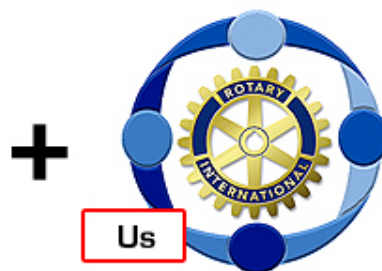
