Since retiring to the Lake of the Ozarks in Missouri, he is actively involved in/or a member of the Shrine of St. Patrick Parish, Knights of Columbus, Westside Chamber of ommerce, Elks, Rotary and the Iowa Club. In addition he volunteers his time at the Laurie Center & Laurie Senior Center and does photography for various organizations and the local community.
