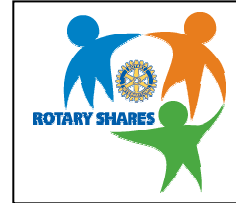

## HOW TO DO AN eCLUB MAKEUP

Much has NOT BEEN SAID about the RI Internet website eClubOne makeup program. For those that may be a little key-stroke shy . . . or short of time . . . here is the perfect opportunity to keep your 100% attendance, or enhance your attendance while helping our club and yourself.

Though not a viable substitute for the real fellowship of Rotary, it does provide an avenue to maintain your attendance and support your club's standing.

A few things before we get started!!

First, get a working COMPUTER with Internet! Internet is a MUST!!

Second, collect the following information so you can move quickly through the Makeup form. Information you will need:

- Your name
- Your vocation, as noted on your Rotary badge
- Club Name: Rotary Club of West El Paso
- District Number: 5520
- Your email address
- Club Secretary for 2007/2008 email address: [tpbrower@sbcglobal.net](mailto:tpbrower@sbcglobal.net)
- Program name(s): You will get this from the program list in Makeup programs on the website.

Easy, huh?

Next, sit in front of or in proximity to your computer, take a moment and go to: "rotaryclubone.org". Click on "eClubOne Welcome". Scroll down to "Rotary eClub Makeup

Programs". Identify a program you want to read, note its name and then click on the program. There is a large and varied selection of topics. Everything from Rotary to Travel is listed! Programs and very short and interesting! Write the program name down or "etch-a-sketch" it into your memory! At the end of the program, click on "Request Makeup Form". The Makeup Form will appear and you will be prompted to fill in the blocks with your information as I noted above in this article about in "Information you will need". Be sure to enter your email address. This will insure you receive an automated confirmation and copy of your makeup form for your records. Also be sure to enter the Club Secretary's email address (provided in the "Information you will need section" listed above) so the Secretary gets an automatic copy of your makeup form – COOL!

Once you complete the form, click SUBMIT. The completed form will appear for your review. Close the window. You will be taken back to the makeup programs. You now have completed the Rotary eClubOne makeup program! When you check your email inbox, you will find your copy/confirmation of the makeup. The Club Secretary will also receive an automated copy of your makeup form . . . you don't have to send it . . . it's automatic when you follow these directions.

eClubOne is a very easy and convenient way to do a Club makeup when you don't have the time or access to another club meeting. Please take a moment to try eClubOne . . . C'mon . . . Try . . . You'll like it!!!
