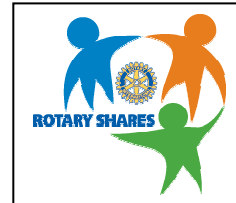

'66 TEXAS WESTERN CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM MEMBER IS SPEAKER AT WELP

Whether one is a UTEP basketball “nut”, an alumnus of UTEP (or Texas Western), a fan of great moments in college basketball, or just someone that has an eye for great moments in our nation's social history, Texas Western's 1966 NCAA Basketball Championship win put El Paso on the map in more ways than one.

Togo Railey, a member of the legendary 1966 team, spoke to the West El Paso Rotary at the October 15th Club meeting. Togo shared some of his experiences, not only from 1966, but more

recently about the team's travel with the making and screening of the movie, *Glory Road*, including a visit to the White House to meet with President and Laura Bush last February.

Just last month, the '66 Miners became the first *team* to be selected the College Basketball of Fame. Togo, proudly wearing his Hall of Fame blazer that he says he only wears for "special occasions", generously slid his Hall of Fame ring off his finger at the meeting and passed it around to the membership to see – see photo below of the ring.

This made one very proud to be an El Pasoan!
