WELP Rotary Adds Another New Member . . .

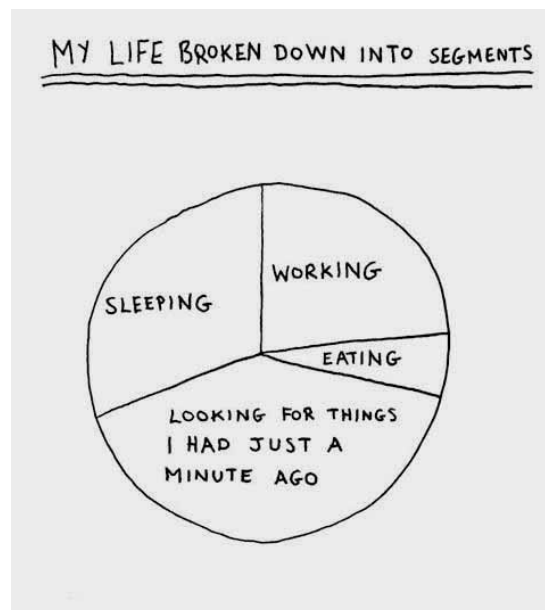
